POSITION: 9-1-1 Calltaker Trainee (part-time)	OPENING DATE: February 1, 2017
SALARY: \$10.95 /hr	APPLICATION DATE: until filled

(Present Parish employees are given three (3) days priority in applying for the vacant position before outside applicants will be considered. Parish employees may still apply after the designated deadline, but priority will not be given.)

DUTIES:

Under the general supervision of the 9-1-1 Coordinator, incumbent is responsible for answering 9-1-1 calls, determining the appropriate transfer agency and implementing a phone transfer to the appropriate agency or agencies. This job is very stressful. Duties must be performed with a high degree of accuracy. Incumbent must be able to communicate clearly and function effectively in stressful situations. Incumbent must possess good typing skills, as well as basic computer skills, and be able to record, transmit and report information accurately. Examples of work include: 1) Receiving phone complaints from the public concerning crimes or emergency situations; 2) Evaluating the caller's needs and transfers caller to the appropriate police, fire or EMS agency or agencies; and 3) Operating phone, computer and recording equipment in a professional manner.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Training and Experience: Must be 21 years of age and a high school graduate.

Knowledge, Abilities and Skills: Basic typing, computer, and telephone skills are required. Must have the ability to communicate clearly and effectively in stressful situations. Knowledge of local geography and pronunciation are important to the performance of this job.
